Please read the following carefully and certify your vehicle insurance coverage is at least the minimum required:

All vehicles must be covered by a liability and property damage insurance policy. The amount of this coverage must meet or exceed the insurance requirement of the state in which the vehicle is licensed and comply with or exceed the requirements of the country of destination for travel outside the United States. According to BSA policy, it is RECOMMENDED that coverage limits are at least \$50,000/\$100,000/\$50,000. Any vehicle designed to carry 10 or more passengers is required to have \$100,000/\$500,000/\$100,000. In the case of rented, vehicles, the requirement of coverage limits can be met by combining the limits of personal coverage carried by the driver with coverage carried by the owner of the rented vehicle.

The State of California requires a minimum of:

- \$15,000 for injury/death to 1 person
- \$30,000 for injury/death to more than 1 person
- <u>\$ 5,000</u> for damage
- \$50,000 total for coverage.
